GIVE IT UP!

We all have desires and things we want. Some are good, some not so good. We choose the ones that are most important to us. Hopefully, one desire we **all** have is wanting to be with our Lord some day. This is a **good** desire! The Lord told us to "**Covet earnestly the best gifts**" - **1 Cor 12:31**. But we must do more than **wish**.

When there is something we **really** want—we work to get it. The more important it is to us, the harder we'll work. As we work though, we should also think about how we can work **more effectively**. We don't want to take two steps forward and then one step back! We want to make every step count. The Lord gave us some advice on this: "**lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us,**" - **Hebrews 12:1**

The Lord tells us to get rid of or **give up** the weights we carry with us, the things that **hamper** us, that **tire** us, that keep us from going as fast and as far as we should. These are the **cares** and riches of this **world**. He told us not to worry about these, to care instead for **spiritual** treasure, things like: **patience, mercy, forgiveness, justice and gentleness**. On Judgment day, wouldn't you like the Lord to extend those things to **you**? Well, He wants **us** to have these spiritual qualities also. Which leads into another area of **giving it up**.

We all know we ought to give up the **bad** things, the things that hinder us, but what about the **good** things we have? I.e., In the sense of sowing; we need to give up our **good** things also—we need to share them with others. But, in order to sow, you must have something to sow. If the farmer ate all of his corn, he wouldn't have any left to plant. We must work to build up these qualities in ourselves, that we'll have some to give to others. The Lord wants us to give away, to others, the **good** things (SPIRITUAL, see list above) we have, so we'll have **even more!**

"**But this I say, He which soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully**" - **2 Corinthians 9:6**

Sure, give up the bad things like selfishness, bitterness, harshness and envy, — but let's **also** give **to** others, the **good** things the Lord has given to us: **patience, mercy, faithfulness, forgiveness, gentleness, etc.** Do that, and we'll find ourselves much closer to obtaining that thing we **really** need:

"Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. " - James 4:8
