FORMING THE HEART

Consider a tree. Cut it down and take it to the lumber mill. The big log may be crooked; a limb here, a knot there. The saw squares the log and turns it straight as an arrow. But, the heart of the tree is still crooked. This well describes Judas Iscariot. He outwardly conformed, but inwardly, his heart was still crooked (John 12:6).

In a similar fashion, we often think that if we do good things, we'll become good—that our heart will become good. But if that were so, the Pharisees should have been good and pleasing in God's sight. They weren't, as Jesus told us:

"Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye make clean the outside of the cup and of the platter, but within they are full of extortion and excess. Thou blind Pharisee, cleanse first that which is within the cup and platter, that the outside of them may be clean also. ." - Matthew 23:25,26

Jesus told them to cleanse first the inside. We need too also. It can be done but only God's way. He's the one, the only one, that knows and tries our hearts (Jeremiah 17:9.10) and the Lord told us how to form our hearts:

"but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind," - Romans 12:2 and He continued to say we must do it:

"that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God

We can't form our heart all at once. It takes time and effort to renew, or change, our mind. Let's realize that and work at it—every day! Why did our Lord tell us to take up our cross daily? He took up his cross to die. So must we—daily! We must die to self and live for God instead (2 Corinthians 5:15). We have to purpose this in our minds. Our desire, not just our actions (read 1 Corinthians 13:3), must be to please God and do His will. That was Jesus' desire. Can we say as He did: "My meat is to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work." - John 4:34? We must—if we are to truly be His disciples and be with Him in heaven!

"If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God. Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth. ... then shall ye also appear with him in glory." - Colossians 3:1-4
