**“ELDERS ... FEED THE FLOCK OF GOD” - 1 Peter 5:1,2**

Sunday morning, Jerry will be preaching at the Boiling Springs church of Christ. **Matt Shelton**, minister of the Thompson church of Christ will speak to us Sunday morning on Evangelism. The Thompson church recently had a very successful Gospel Meeting (that Jerry preached) due in large part to everyone in the congregation being diligent to invite people they knew to attend—and then following up with them to ensure they did attend.

Tom Rinehart will bring us a sermon Sunday evening from God's word on how God introduced his son, which will serve very well to reinforce this quarter's Sunday Bible Class studies on Jesus The Christ. All of this subject to the Lord's will of course.

The first lesson in our study on Jesus, emphasized the fact the Jesus is God! He was our creator, yet he left heaven to redeem sinful man:

**“All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made.” - John 1:3**

**“Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men:” - Philippians 2:6,7**

He did this because He loved us. He left us an example to follow. Are you?

**BRING A NON-MEMBER GUEST – BRING A SOUL! BRING SEVERAL!! TO OUR GOSPEL MEETING!**

The elders want **all** members to commit and make a special effort to have at least one non-member attend our meeting. Not just invite them – but work to make sure they attend! Maybe a family member, a friend, a co-worker, or a neighbor. Personally invite them! Give them the Gospel Meeting sheet and a Personal Invitation Card. Then **CALL THEM** and follow-up! When the meeting is over, it will be too late. Will those you care about have attended? Will there be more you could have done? Think on this and be diligent in inviting people to attend and then—following up with them! When you consider that **eternity** is long and **judgment** is sure, are there **any** good excuses not to have done so? May the Lord bless you according to your efforts:
