Preaching the Word

Over the next three months, perhaps longer, the sermons on Sunday morning will take us through some basics of New Testament Christianity and foundations for our faith. It is always wise for a church to work through such things periodically. Having been here for a couple of months now I thought it best to cover these topics not knowing to what extent they have been covered previously. This is not to assume such has not been covered previously but in looking to the future we want to build on a solid foundation. A solid Biblical foundation is based upon sound doctrine which begins with the "first principles" found in the scriptures.

The topics we'll cover over the next few months are grouped into three broad categories. The first is the Bible itself. We have to love the word of God and use it to live for and do anything for Him. The second category is the Church. We'll look at what the church is, how God planned and purposed it, and its distinctive nature. The third category will be called "Christian Practice," and this is the broadest of the three. Under this umbrella we'll examine items such as Christian worship, Christian living, and Spiritual Disciplines.

It is my hope and prayer that such lessons will help "equip the saints for the work of ministry, for the building up the body of Christ," as the apostle Paul wrote in Ephesians 4:12. Every sermon really and truly should seek to do that, but over the next few months the aim is to teach and remind the church of the foundations for which the body of Christ is built upon and was built for.

How do you view the Bible?

- 1. It was given to the world unlike any other book.
 - a. 2 Timothy 3:16
 - b.2 Peter 3:20-21
- 2. Do you understand what God expects the Bible to accomplish?

All things considered; do you treat the Bible like it's from God or some where else?

FORMING THE HEART

Cut a tree and take it to the saw mill. The log is crooked with a limb here and a knot there. The saw squares the log and makes it straight as an arrow, but the *heart* of the tree is still crooked. **Judas** was like that. He *outwardly* conformed, but inwardly, his heart was still crooked (Matthew 26:14-16).

Many think if we **do** good things, we'll **become** good—our heart will become good. Some ask themselves: **WWJD**—What Would Jesus **Do**. And they're plumb **wrong!** If that were all it took, the **Pharisees** would have been **good** and **pleasing** in God's sight. But, they **weren't**, as Jesus told us in **Matthew 23:28**: "Even so you also outwardly appear righteous unto men, but within you are full of hypocrisy and iniquity."

Jesus told them to cleanse first the inside **so** the outside might be clean! **That** is the way it's done. But, we can't work directly on our hearts (Jeremiah 17:9,10). Instead we form our hearts by changing our **minds** as the Lord told us in **Romans** 12:2: "But be ye transformed by the renewing of your MIND"

We need to empty our **minds** of thoughts of self and replace them with thoughts of God that we get **from His word**—the Bible. This is how God works on us—through His word. This takes time. We must work at it **every** day, purging ourselves of self and **reading** from God's word. Our Lord told us to do this **very thing** in **Luke 9:23**: "If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow me."

Jesus meant it! He took up his cross to **die!** So must **we** - daily! Die to self so we can **live** for God, feeding on His word so we might grow (1 Peter 2:2).

To form our hearts, it must be clear in our minds that we've been **bought!** "And that he died for all, that they which live should not henceforth live unto themselves, but unto him which died for them, and rose again." - 2 Corinthians. 5:15 By the grace of God we can be redeemed if we do His will. We can belong to God and gain victory over death. It's so easy to find rest:

"Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light."—Matthew 11:29

"Blessed *are* they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled." Matthew 5:6
