Can you answer that in confidence? Can you answer it at all? Are you a Christian because...

- You arew up in the church.
- You want Heaven as a safety net.
- Nothing else convinced you.

Or are vou a Christian because ...

- You really understood that you were dead in your sins. Ephesians 2:1.
- You sincerely responded to the love of Christ. 1 John 4:19.
- You knew it was time to concede to Christ/could no longer deny truth. Galatians 2:20; John 19:38: 20:24-28
- You searched diligently for His church. Hebrews. 11:9-10; 1 Peter 1:10-11

Is why you became a Christian still important to you?

"... If ye continue in my word, *then* are ye my disciples indeed" - John 8:31

SHOW GOD YOU'RE THANKFUL

How do you **thank** someone? You might shake their hand, or give them a kiss and tell them so, or you might write them a note. But the best way is to **show** them you're thankful for what you've received-that you treasure it and use it. God hasn't neglected instructing us in this regard either. In 1 Peter 1:3 God said He would give us "all things that pertain unto life and godliness". One way He has done so is in giving us a way we can show Him we are thankful for the great gift of life, hope and peace He has given us through His Son:

"And above all things have fervent charity among yourselves: for charity shall cover the multitude of sins. Use hospitality one to another without grudging. As every man hath received the gift, even so minister the same one to another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God." - 1 Peter 4:8-10

The gifts (manifold grace) we have received He wants us to give to others. Good stewards MINISTER! He doesn't want us to lock up and guard what we've received like the one talent man. Instead He wants us to minister, give what we've received to others. This is the **right** way to show God you're thankful.

"freely ye have received, freely give" - Matthew 10:8

God gave us His word, to *keep* us from sin, so we might live and be with Him. Show Him you're thankful—STUDY IT! Be ready to speak to others of it (1 Peter 3:15). The below little snippet tells us *what* we should do (walk, even as He walked) and a good reason why (he is the propitiation, our satisfaction to God).

"My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous: And he is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world. And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his commandments. He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him. But whoso keepeth his word, in him verily is the love of God perfected: hereby know we that we are in him. He that saith he abideth in him ought himself also so to walk, even as he walked." - 1 John 2:1-6

And if we aren't thankful for this, if we don't value it enough to share?

"Because that, when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened." - Romans 1:21

But, if we are thankful (and give evidence of it, as with our faith) we will have peace:

"And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful." - Colossians 3:15
