Free Coffee

Chick-Fil-A, unquestionably the greatest fast-food restaurant in existence (Zesto is not considered fast-food) has made either a brilliant move or a mistake which will cost them thousands of dollars, or maybe just hundreds; I don't really know as I am not privy to their accounting department. Either way, for myself this only raised their stock in my eyes. I am referring to the offering of free coffee this month. I'm sure many of you are aware of this (assuming "many" people will read this, maybe I should say "both" instead of "many"). In case you are unaware all month long in February you can walk into any Chick-Fil-A at anytime and order a small coffee or iced coffee free of charge. The obvious question to ask is, "Why do people put ice in their coffee?"

The benefits of this for the restaurant are not hard to see. People come for free coffee and accidentally order stuff on the menu which is not free. They also stand to grow their customer base if people like the coffee and do not mind paying for it after February. For the customer the thought is "Free coffee!" While the coffee is free it is not without requirement. There is the time it takes to get the coffee and the gas consumed to go get the coffee. Chick-Fil-A cannot give you your time back and they have not worked out a reimbursement plan for the consumer with the gas people. But if it's free we usually don't care about those items because we got the priority item and nothing came out of the wallet. The time and gas are just part of what it takes to get the coffee.

Acts 20:28 reads "Be on guard for yourselves and for all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood." Our salvation did not cost us anything, but Jesus paid everything for it. Jesus has requirements for the salvation He provides. Oddly enough we take issue with His requirements. Far too often after baptism too many would-be followers of Christ are not willing to put forth the effort it takes to live the Christian life. How much stronger could the church be, how much more would we accomplish if we looked at the requirements of following Christ the same way we do as the requirements for getting free stuff from a store?

Sun AM Sermon— A Love of the Truth, 2 Thessalonians 2:1-12

- 1. There is truth and there is everything else.
- 2. Something separates those who believe truth from those who do not.
- 3. Love of the truth is mandatory in order to act in accordance with truth.
- 4. What will a love of the truth accomplish?

The Gospel's Power To Save

There must be some connection made between power and the thing to be moved. There is great power in a locomotive, but it cannot move the train of cars till proper connection is made with power.

There is sufficient power in the gospel to move every sinner out of sin into the blessings of salvation, but that power moves no one until proper connections are made. Preaching is the means of establishing that connection. It is God's way of bringing the sinner under the influence of his saving power. For that reason, Paul was not ashamed to preach it. (Rom. 1:16).

The gospel exerts no power over the heathen who has never heard it, nor over the infidel who will not hear it, and it exerts but little power over him who looks for the power to come some other way. It exerts a power over us for good to the extent that we place ourselves under the influence of its teaching. The cyclone has no power over the man who is safely hidden away in his storm cellar, but it would be foolish for him to come out after the storm and confidently affirm that there was no power in the cyclone, but no more foolish than for a man who will not heed God's word to affirm that there is no converting power in it.

Genuine Faith

Genuine faith is based on evidence that admits of no doubt, and to believe in a person means more than to believe that such a person exists. "He that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him" (Heb. 11:6). In addition to accepting the truth that God is, we confidently trust Him for the fulfillment of His promises. In all genuine faith there is, therefore, the element of confidence and trust. We trust Him to fulfill His promises, and we confide in His wisdom and goodness.

It is true that Abel heard God's command and obeyed, and therefore he made his offering by faith (Gen. 4:4; Heb. 11:4). But there was something back of all that. Why did he do what God said, and why did not Cain do what God said? Abel had confidence in God's wisdom and goodness. Cain had confidence in his own wisdom and way. Hence, Abel followed God's way and Cain followed his own way. Abel did what God commanded because he had more confidence in God than in himself.
